Dear Parents/Students

Special Post Confinement Circular

1. All rules and regulations as per circular No. 01 of January 2020 and also stipulated on the front cover of the notebook still hold on.
However, given the present circumstances, you are also requested to abide strictly by the following measures.
2. The school will not admit any student suffering from “flu” or any other disease in the morning. Such students will be allowed on school premises **ONLY WHEN** they have fully recovered. No partly recovered students should be sent to school. The temperature of all students will be examined during the morning following instructions laid down by the Ministry of Education.
3. Students should not play, touch each other, lay hands on each other’s shoulders or share books and copybooks and other students materials such as pens, compasses, pencils, pencil erasers and so on and so forth.
4. Students are strictly advised to bring food, water or juice from home as it would be safer for them.
5. Classrooms should be kept tidy (neat and orderly). There should be no piece of bread or paper on the floor. Untidy behaviour will be severely dealt with.
6. Students should wear **WHITE FACE MASKS** and replace same at least once a week. Learners should, by no means, share their face masks. Such a behaviour can entail dangerous health consequences. **FACE MASKS** other than white will not be accepted on school premises.
7. Students should keep a reasonable distance between each other. The school will be very strict and never compromise on that measure.

8. During this post covid19 period up to November 2020, there will be no detention classes. However, all students who will be found guilty of aggression, robbery or damaging school property will be either rusticated or expelled depending on the gravity of the offence.
9. As usual, notebooks will be signed by form masters/mistresses each Friday. Learners should fill in their notes properly.
10. Students will be informed of the day, time and place when school materials will be made available.
11. Parents are encouraged to come and pick up their wards in the afternoon if they do have possibility and means to do so. If they do turn up in the afternoon, they should wait for their children at the entrance alley while maintaining social distancing.
12. As usual, mobile phones are strictly forbidden on school premises.
13. Students should wear the school uniform (Imperial College blue trousers and white shirt with badge) for learners of all Grades. (Grades 7 to 13).
14. Students are reminded that they should abide by the Imperial College haircut style, that is (number 2 cut for students of Grades 7, 8 and 9) and (number 3 cut for Grades 10, 11, 12 and 13). Imperial College will **NOT TOLERATE** any beard style or side whiskers.
