
1. INDEPENDENCE DAY:


Dear Parents/Students,

- The 54th Independence Anniversary and 30th Anniversary of the Republic of Mauritius will be celebrated at school level on Friday the 11th of March 2022.
- Students should attend school dressed in their school uniform with proper Imperial hairstyle.
- **No mobile phone** should be brought at school on that day.
- Students should leave their bags, books and copybooks at home.
- They will enter their respective classrooms when the bell goes at 8.00 a.m and will be under the supervision of grademasters / grademistresses.
- The Prime Minister's message will be read at 9.30 a.m by the grademaster / grademistress after which students will receive refreshment and cakes.
- School will dismiss at 11.00 a.m. After school releases, students should return home immediately and not linger in town or elsewhere. Our team of discipline masters will move around to spot all those Imperial College students who will be wandering around instead of going back home.

2. 1st TERM EXAMS:

- 1st term exams will start on Monday the 21st of March 2022 and end on Thursday the 31st of March same year.
- Learners will sit for those exams in their actual respective classrooms. The subject teachers will act as invigilators.
- Exams will start at 8.00 a.m and end at 11.45 a.m or 12.05 p.m depending on the student's grade. Normal classes will be run from 12.05 p.m to 2.15 p.m after exams sessions.
