1. 2021/2022 CAMBRIDGE OCTOBER/NOVEMBER EXAMINATIONS

SC - % Pass – 96.15	- Entries - 130	No. of Passes – 125

2. Grade 12 - 2023 / Grade 13 – 2024 – To succeed the Grade 12 Examinations, a student must have at least: Passes in **Two** (2) subjects at PRINCIPAL / A Level and passes in **Two** (2) subjects at ADVANCED SUBSIDIARY / AS Level (not worse than Grade C).

Only those students who succeed the 2023 Grade 12 Examinations will be promoted to Grade 13 and will be allowed to sit for the 2024 HIGHER SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATIONS.

To opt for a subject at Principal / 'A' Level 2023, students must have a CREDIT in the subject at SC Level. Students who cannot yet comply with this regulation, are strongly advised to re-sit for the 2023 May-June or 2023 October-November School Certificate Examinations.

3. Regarding admission to Grade 12 in 2023, students would be required to have passed SC with five credits or obtained the G.C.E equivalent at one and the same sitting. Credits in English, French and Mathematics are essential to be admitted to Grade 12.

4. REPEATING A CLASS IN 2023 – Imperial College **cannot guarantee** a seat to **repeat any class**. It depends on the number of available seats and the academic results of the students.

The seats available will be **allocated** to students with the best performance. In the event of an excess demand for a particular class coupled with similar performance, the principle of **first come** will be exercised. The first entrants will be given priority.

To **REPEAT SC** in 2023, a student must have obtained:

Either **THREE (3) CREDITS** and **ONE (1) PASS** or **FOUR (4) CREDITS** – Including a credit in ENGLISH, FRENCH and MATHS in the October/November 2022 SC/GCE exams.

To **REPEAT HSC** in 2023, a student must have obtained at least: **TWO (2) subjects at Advanced Level** and **TWO (2) subjects at Advanced Subsidiary Level** in the October/November 2022 HSC/GCE Exams.

5. MONTHLY ASSESSMENTS

There are **five** for the whole year. Students are assessed in all the subjects each month. By the end of the respective month, marks will be entered in the progress books of the students. Responsible Parties must consult the progress books to know how their wards are performing. They must also **SIGN** in the space provided for.
