1. 2019 CAMBRIDGE OCTOBER / NOVEMBER EXAMINATIONS

HSC - % Pass – 80.49%	- Entries – 82	No of Passes – 66
SC - % Pass – 90.06%	- Entries – 181	No of Passes – 163

2. Grade 12 - 2020 – Grade 13 – 2021 - To succeed the Lower VI Examinations, a student must have at least: Passes in **Two** (2) subjects at PRINCIPAL / A Level and passes in **Two** (2) subjects at ADVANCED SUBSIDIARY / AS Level (not worse than Grade C).

Only those students who succeed the 2020 Grade 12 Examinations will be promoted to Grade 13 and allowed to sit for the 2021 HIGHER SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATIONS.

To opt for a subject at Principal / A' Level in 2021, students must have a CREDIT in the subject at SC level. Students, who cannot yet comply with this regulation, are strongly advised to re-sit for the 2020 May – June / October – November School Certificate examinations.

3. With regards to admission to Grade 12 in 2021, students would be required to have passed SC with five credits (or obtained the G.C.E. equivalent at one and the same sitting. Credits in English, French and Mathematics are essential for admission to Grade 12.

4. REPEATING A CLASS IN 2021 - Imperial College **cannot guarantee** a seat to **repeat any class**. It depends on the number of available seats and the academic results of the students.

The seats available will be **allocated** to students with the best performance. In the event of an excess demand for a particular class coupled with similar performance, the principle of **first come** will be exercised. The first entrants will be given priority.

To **REPEAT SC** in 2021, a student must have obtained:

Either **THREE (3) CREDITS** and **ONE (1) PASS** or **FOUR (4) CREDITS** - Including a credit in **ENGLISH, FRENCH** and **MATHS** in the 2020 SC / GCE exams.

To **REPEAT HSC** in 2021, a student must have obtained at least: **TWO (2) subjects at Advanced Level** and **TWO (2) subjects at Advanced Subsidiary level** in the 2020 HSC / GCE exams.

5. MONTHLY ASSESSMENTS - The first monthly assessment for 2020 will be held during the month of February. There are six for the whole year. Students are assessed in all the subjects each month. By the end of the respective month, marks will be entered in the progress books of the students. Responsible parties must consult the progress books to know how their wards are performing. They must also **SIGN** in the space provided for.

6. MEETING OF RESPONSIBLE PARTIES - Meetings of responsible parties are currently being held. Letters are sent to the responsible parties to inform them when such meetings are held for the different classes. Responsible parties must necessarily attend the meetings, in which important guidelines are provided.

7. SCHOOL HOLIDAY – MAHA SHIVARATHRI 2020 – To allow our students and members of the staff to participate in the Maha Shivarathri's pilgrimage, **THURSDAY 20th FEBRUARY 2020** will be a **SCHOOL HOLIDAY**.
