1. WINTER DRESS:

Non participants (spectators) should attend school dressed in their Imperial uniform. A thorough search will be carried out at the entrance to the school. All those caught with prohibited substances will be expelled. Students have to abide by the Rules and Regulations.

3. PRIZE GIVING DAY:

The prize giving ceremony will be held on Friday 31st May 2024 as from 9.00 a.m. Our guest of honour on that special occasion will be **Mr Sem RAMJUNUM**, Barrister at Law.

Students should be in attendance at school as from 08.10 a.m. on that day. They should be dressed in the proper Imperial College uniform (Imperial blue trousers/shorts, white shirt with Imperial badge, Imperial jacket and socks). No need to bring along bags, books and copybooks.

Students will not be admitted on the school compound on that day if they do not satisfy the following criteria:
