**1. 2025 CAMBRIDGE OCTOBER/NOVEMBER EXAMINATIONS**

SC - % Pass – 92.45	- Entries - 159	No. of Passes – 147
HSC- % Pass – 86.15	- Entries – 65	No. of Passes – 56

**2. Grade 12 - 2026 / Grade 13 – 2027** – To succeed the Grade 12 Examinations, a student must have at least: Passes in **Two** (2) subjects at PRINCIPAL / A Level and passes in **Two** (2) subjects at ADVANCED SUBSIDIARY / AS Level (not worse than Grade C).

Only those students who succeed the 2026 Grade 12 Examinations will be promoted to Grade 13 and will be allowed to sit for the 2027 HIGHER SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATIONS.

To opt for a subject at Principal / ‘A’ Level 2026, students must have a CREDIT in the subject at SC Level. Students who cannot yet comply with this regulation, are strongly advised to re-sit for the 2026 May/June or 2026 October/November School Certificate Examinations.

**3.** Regarding admission to Grade 12 in 2027, students would be required to have passed SC with five credits or obtained the G.C.E equivalent at one and the same sitting. Credits in English, French and Mathematics are essential to be admitted to Grade 12.

**4. REPEATING A CLASS IN 2027** – Imperial College **cannot guarantee** a seat to **repeat any class**. It depends on the number of available seats and the academic results of the students.

The seats available will be **allocated** to students with the best performance. In the event of an excess demand for a particular class coupled with similar performance, the principle of **first come** will be exercised. The first entrants will be given priority.

To **REPEAT SC** in 2027, a student must have obtained:

Either **THREE (3) CREDITS** and **ONE (1) PASS** or **FOUR (4) CREDITS** – Including a credit in **ENGLISH, FRENCH** and **MATHS** in the October/November 2026 SC/GCE exams.

To **REPEAT HSC** in 2027, a student must have obtained at least: **TWO (2) subjects at Advanced Level** and **TWO (2) subjects at Advanced Subsidiary Level** in the October/November 2026 HSC/GCE Exams.

## 5. MONTHLY ASSESSMENTS

There are **four** for the whole year. Students are assessed in all the subjects each month. By the end of the respective month, marks will be entered in the progress books of the students. Responsible Parties must consult the progress books to know how their wards are performing. They must also **SIGN** in the space provided for.

## 6. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The school uniform must **always** be worn by the students when attending school (within and outside school premises) even for **INTERNAL/EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS (NCE/SC/HSC)**.

- White shirts with badge sewn, tucked into short (Grades 7 to 9) and trousers (Grades 10 to 13)
- Blue shorts (Grade 7 to 9); Blue trousers (Grades 10 to 13). **No slim fit trousers will be tolerated.**
- A proper hair cut no. 2 or 3 with appropriate side whiskers and no beard style.
- Appropriate white or black shoes and Imperial socks.
- **White and blue jackets as per Imperial sample and design.**

## 7. MOBILE PHONE / SMART WATCH

The Management will not be responsible for any damage or loss of personal belongings at school. Students must **NOT BRING UNDESIRABLE MATERIALS** such as **MOBILE PHONE, SMART WATCH, VALUABLES** (sophisticated calculators, electronic games), **OFFENSIVE GADGETS** (steel rulers, pocket knives, cutters) and **CORRECTION FLUID (BLANCO)** such items, when found in possession of the student, will be confiscated.

**In case a mobile phone is brought at school, in spite of the interdiction as stipulated, used in whatever way, and, recorded material posted on social media (facebook, Instagram, whatsapp...), very severe action (even legal action) might be taken against the guilty party.**
